Sermon Recap

The word “blessed” is thrown around quite a bit, and sometimes we get a bit confused as to what it really means. We say “I’m blessed” when what we really are is *lucky, fortunate, or even privileged*. But, being *blessed* is really about God acting in our lives and equipping us for good works of love. And so, what if we began to approach our whole lives with an understanding that *we’re already blessed*. In other words, God has already begun acting in our lives and preparing us for good works of love. With what has God entrusted to us? What resources are already in our hands that God is inviting us to use in order to add goodness to the world. Being good stewards is all about understanding that *we’re already blessed*.

*Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight.
In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.
Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord, and turn away from evil.*
