"Earn all you can, save all you can, give all you can." This is the summary of John Wesley's sermon "On money." When we read this, we might first notice that the first two rules seem quite favorable! So long as we're doing them ethically, no problem! But, then we read the third rule, and we suddenly realize that there's a catch! But what are we to give to? That's the big question! What if we were to give ourselves permission to let our passion guide our giving? What do we see changing the world and get excited about? How might our giving be impacted if we get excited about what we're giving to?

"Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. ¹¹ If then you have not been faithful with the dishonest wealth,^[d] who will entrust to you the true riches? ¹² And if you have not been faithful with what belongs to another, who will give you what is your own?"
