

Adult Ministries

- ♦ **Pastor's Drop-In Bible Study** - Every Thursday at 10 am during the school year. Pastor Brian lead an hour long Bible Study, taking a careful look at one book of the Bible at a time. Whether you're super familiar with the Bible, or opening it for the first time, this class is for you. There's no start or end date, and it's not a problem if you have to miss a session or two. Just come and bring yourself.
- ♦ **Sunday School** - We are currently offering two adult Sunday School classes, Perspective and *Youngish*. Perspectives will use a variety of short-term studies to journey through a number of faith subjects, books of the Bible, and more. *Youngish* is designed for our Youngish adults. This class will utilize a video-based curriculum to help ignite thoughtful conversation.
- ♦ **Men's Coffee** - Men of all ages gather each Friday mornings at 10 am at church to share a cup of coffee and conversation.
- ♦ **United Methodist Men (UMM)** - The United Methodist Men's purpose is to help men grow in Christ, so others may know Christ. Our UMM support several of the ministries of our church, especially our children's ministries.
- ♦ **United Methodist Women (UMW)** - The vision of the United Methodist Women is turning faith, hope, and love into action on behalf of women, children, and youth around the world. Our circles meet monthly, on the 3rd Wednesday of the month at 10:00 a.m.
- ♦ **Seasoned Citizens** - We are a group made up primarily of retired folks. (All adults are welcome!). We meet at Noon every 2nd Thursday of each month Sept. through May and enjoy fellowship, a potluck luncheon and a program.
- ♦ **Prayer Shawl** - A group of friends coming together on a weekly basis for fellowship. Friendship and fun. They do ministry for others creating wearable hugs (a.k.a. Prayer Shawls.) This group currently meets outside in the church parking lot usually on Wednesdays or Fridays; date may vary due to weather. Contact the church office for weekly meeting times. No knowledge of knitting or crocheting is necessary, just come and visit.
