- Keep one or all of the parking lot islands weed free. Rake up the mulch every few weeks and add some bright flowers, if possible.
- Use a trimmer to go around posts, playground fencing, etc.
- Use the church's big wheelbarrow to bring any cut wood to the asphalt curb so that it will be easier for people to take it.
- Keep the fence row between the parking lot and Indian Hill clean (please see Bob Mills for specifics)
