World Communion Sunday *Three Dreamers* Sermon: "Joseph, the Interpreter"

And Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I had a dream, and there is no one who can interpret it. I have heard it said of you that when you hear a dream you can interpret it." Joseph answered Pharaoh, "It is not I; God will give Pharaoh a favorable answer." Let Pharaoh proceed to appoint overseers over the land and take one-fifth of the produce of the land of Egypt during the seven plenteous years. Let them gather all the food of these good years that are coming and lay up grain under the authority of Pharaoh for food in the cities and let them keep it. That food shall be a reserve for the land of Egypt, so that the land may not perish through the famine."

## **Thoughts to Consider Before the Sermon:**

1. The dream Joseph interprets is one that could lead to Egypt's ultimate downfall. Why didn't it?

- 3. How can the spiritual task of dreaming invite our church to consider where God is leading us?
